Motioned by S. Hennigar seconded by Flurer to approve Resolution (24-13) approving FY25 Budget (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by Flurer seconded by McOllough to approve Recommendation on Hotel Motel Grant to Grand View Beef for \$5,000 (Motion passed 5-0).

Comments from the Council or Dept heads: Mayor brought to the attention of Chief TerHark there is an increase of bicycles riding on North 2nd St NW. There is a ton of traffic on this road including semi's that do not have the ability to stop quickly. Make sure inexperienced riders are contacted of hazards if seen.
